The rider was swiftly detained, failed a roadside drugs wipe and was arrested for various offences


The motorcycle had recently been stolen and has been recovered &

Following an investigation by our Major Crime Unit, today five men have been convicted in connection with a murder in High Wycombe.

Jayden Gubetini, aged 18, of Coe Spur, Slough, was found guilty by unanimous jury verdict of one count each of murder, attempted murder, conspiracy to rob and section 18 grievous bodily harm with intent. He was found not guilty of one count of attempted murder.

Philip Solomon, aged 38, of no fixed abode, previously pleaded guilty to one count of conspiracy to rob. He was found not guilty of one count each of attempted murder, grievous bodily harm, murder and manslaughter.

Scott Cordice, aged 30, of Station Close, High Wycombe, was found guilty by unanimous jury verdict of one count of conspiracy to rob. He was found not guilty of one count each of attempted murder, grievous bodily harm, murder and manslaughter.

Aaran Pattinson, aged 33, of Station Close, High Wycombe, previously pleaded guilty to one count each of manslaughter and conspiracy to rob. He was found not guilty of attempted murder, grievous bodily harm and murder.

Marlon Cato, aged 51, of Station Close, High Wycombe, was found guilty by majority jury verdict of two counts of possession with intent to supply a controlled drug of class A drug and guilty by unanimous jury verdict of one count of assisting an offender.

The convictions relate to the death of Cameron Bailey, a 17-year-old boy from West Sussex and the wounding of his friend, also aged 17 at the time.

Cordice, Pattinson, Solomon and Cato were charged on 11 and 12 May last year.

Having fled to the Netherlands, Gubetini was returned to the UK on 5 July last year and was put before the court the following day.

Solomon, Pattinson, Cordice and Catoare due to be sentenced at Reading Crown Court on 21 November.

Gubetini is due to be sentenced on a date to be confirmed.

Special Constabulary Update

We let you know on Saturday that our Specials had been in on a specific tasking.

We can now share they were conducting arrest attempts on behalf of the Proactive Team for persons wanted on Warrant for Failure to Appear at Court.

16 Arrest attempts were made across the LCU.

3 Wanted persons were arrested, and having spent up to 36hrs in one of our cells will be put in front of the courts today!





A reminder that the clocks change tonight. At 2am Sunday morning, the clocks go back by an hour.


