MARLOW NHPT ISSUE COMMUNITY PROTECTION WARNING

Officers from Marlow NHPT have issued Community Protection Warnings to individuals at an address in the Gunthorpe Road estate. Extract, as follows:

'This letter is issued by Thames Valley Police, in partnership with Buckinghamshire Council, because it is considered that you are responsible for behaviour which is persistent and/or continuing, and that this is having a detrimental impact on the quality of lives of others in the local community. This behaviour is believed to be unreasonable. This letter is a written warning in respect of this behaviour.

I am satisfied that this is necessary on reasonable grounds that:

- (a) Your conduct is having a detrimental effect, of a persistent or continuing nature, on the quality of life of those in the locality, and that:
- (b) The conduct is unreasonable.

If you fail to comply with the above actions, then we will consider serving you with a Community Protection Notice (CPN). This notice will tell you the things that you must do to put these problems right. If you fail to do so without reasonable excuse you may be prosecuted.

Marlow NHPT will not tolerate ASB and will look to deal with such issues swiftly and robustly in order to protect our community.

These two people are Aaron Birbeck (left) and Connor McVay (right).

They've been jailed for 11 years and eight years respectively for two violent robberies and other offences in Amersham and Chesham Bois in February last year.

A 16-year-old boy, who can't be named for legal reasons, was also given a two-year youth rehabilitation order for two counts of robbery.

Our colleagues from Herts Police assisted in the arrest of the three offenders following a pursuit across several counties on 29 February 2024.

We will never tolerate such violence in our communities.

These two men are now locked up for a considerable period of time.

We are continuing to investigate this incident whereby a Hyundai collided with six teenage girls and two vehicles.

We can confirm that we believe the incident to be the result of a medical episode rather than a criminal act and as such this matter has been referred to the DVLA.

The driver was released from hospital yesterday.

We continue to liaise with the John Hampden Grammar School and ensure all parties are updated on the investigation.
