


CHARGED =

Following an investigation, Laurence Hunter, aged 26, of Weedon Road, Aylesbury, has been charged with two counts of robbery, and a count each of criminal damage and attempted theft.

The charges are in relation to incidents in High Wycombe on 12 and 17 December.

Hunter appeared at High Wycombe Magistrates' Court on Saturday and was remanded in custody to appear at Aylesbury Crown Court on 21 January 2025.



How has 2024 been for you?

As we reflect on the past year, we'd like to share with you the achievements of our Special Constabulary officers based in Buckinghamshire. Together, they have volunteered over 5286 hours to policing our communities, the equivalent to 2.5 full-time police officers.

Throughout the year, our officers have responded to over 250 Grade 1 & 2 incidents, including thefts, burglaries, robberies, public order and domestic incidents. They have safeguarded 54 vulnerable adults & children, attended 28 fear for welfare cases, and helped to locate 35 missing individuals.

On the roads, our team has responded to 33 road traffic collisions, conducted 224 vehicle stops, issued 18 fixed penalties, and seized 8 vehicles.

We have also completed 19 Stop & Searches, conducted 58 ASB Hotspot patrols, arrested 21 suspects and assisted in the arrest of a further 46 individuals.

This is still only a small snapshot of the work we've completed in 2024!

Looking ahead to 2025, we look forward to welcoming new colleagues to our team, continuing to support local and forcewide operations, and assisting our regular colleagues across the LCU.


