Following the disorder in High Wycombe on Saturday, there will continue to be an increased police presence in the Castlefield area to keep people safe.

The Section 60 order, which temporarily extends our powers to stop and search people, ends at 7pm today.

However, we remain in the area to provide reassurance to the community so please speak to a uniformed officer if you have any concerns.

We are appealing for witnesses to the incident of public disorder in High Wycombe yesterday.

Eight men were involved in the disorder in the Rutland Avenue and Spearing Road area at around 5.20pm. We have arrested five men so far, two of whom are in hospital with serious injuries.

The Section 60 order enacted in the Castlefield area has been extended for a further 24 hours to prevent further violence, so is now due to expire at 7pm tomorrow.

We understand this disorder may be concerning for the community but we believe those involved were known to each other and we have do not believe there is any threat to the wider public. Nevertheless, we have put the Section 60 order in place and increased patrols in the area while we continue to investigate the incident as a priority.

Special Constabulary Update

Last night over 2/3's of our Specials met at Aylesbury for a local training evening - our first since we became Bucks LCU and a rare opportunity for us to come together as a whole team. #oneteam

Did you know, Specials complete the same mandatory training as our regular colleagues, as set by the College of Policing? This includes annual 2 days of Personal Safety Training and 1 day Emergency First Aid.

Last night however we built on our core learning, by receiving an input from the National Centre for Domestic Violence, outlining the free services they provide to victims of Domestic Violence & Abuse, and how these can complement our policing powers. https://orlo.uk/Lfm0E

This was followed by a discussion on the wellbeing services available internally to TVP staff and how we manage mental trauma associated with the various incidents we and other emergency services colleagues may attend. #mentalwellbeing

The evening finished with a talk from CSI on current best practice of obtaining forensic evidence at crime scenes, delivered as a walk-through of one of the LCUs more recent historical major crimes.

This coming weekend we'll be out supporting our regular colleagues as usual, finding opportunities to put our new learning into use.
