We are appealing for witnesses following an incident of a possession of an offensive weapon in High Wycombe.


At around 10pm on Tuesday, the victim was in his car on Ryemead Way when two men got out of a silver Peugeot 308.

Chow San Dylan Lo, aged 28, has been jailed for more than five and a half years for supply of class A drugs in High Wycombe.


He was sentenced at Aylesbury Crown Court on Wednesday.

Following an investigation, a man has been charged in connection with an attempted murder in Amersham.

Harry Benson, aged 27, of White Lion Road, Amersham, was charged yesterday with two counts of possession of a bladed article and one count each of attempted murder, possession of a sharply pointed article, possession of an offensive weapon in a private place and possession of a controlled drug of class B, namely cannabis.

The charges relate to an assault at around 6.40pm on Friday on Dane Close.


Benson was remanded in custody and is due to appear at Aylesbury Crown Court on 7 October.




