Marian Stancu, pictured, has been sentenced to a year and six months in prison for dangerous driving and other offences.

At around 2.50am on Saturday 20 July, Stancu pulled out in front of Roads Policing officers on West Wycombe Road, cutting up other traffic.

When requested to stop, Stancu failed to do so and continued to drive in a dangerous manner.

He then crashed into rails at the roundabout by Wycombe police station, and assaulted a police officer.

Stancu was arrested and charged on the same day.


As part of Operation Grotto, today our Priority Crime Team and Neighbourhood Officers have arrested two people in relation to Burglary's that have taken place in Chesham.



As part of ASB week I will share the returns from the High Wycombe NH team for Monday: Work resulted in 5 stop searches - A community resolution issued for possession of class A drugs, a PND issued for possession of cannabis, 2 arrests, 1 com res for shop lifting, 1 referral to ORB, 1 traffic ticket for leaving a van unattended with the engine on, a school visit and lecture and house to house enquiries around a burglary in Totteridge. A busy and productive day for the team.

This is on the back of an increased presence of uniformed Police on foot patrol in the town centre targeting shoplifting and ASB. #WycombeNHP





Officers on OP Grotto are out this chilly evening, completing patrols in South Buckinghamshire, especially areas along the A355. Officers have also been responding to a suspicious vehicle in the High Wycombe area, suspected to be linked to burglaries. 

The Wycombe neighbourhood policing team have been busy with Anti-social behaviour awareness week, the national campaign for tackling ASB in the community. Here's some of what we've been up to so far:

We've worked with Bucks council & one recovery Bucks for some joint patrols and engagement with vulnerable members of the community around the town centre

We've been speaking with our retail community to understand how anti-social behaviour impacts their businesses and give them advice on reporting

Several stop searches were carried out and numerous arrests were made in relation to anti-social behaviour

We held a pop up police stand with a member of Bucks mediation to offer advice to local residents

We have also held multiple talks with the local schools to educate our younger community on anti-social behaviour and community safety.

For the rest of the week we will be carrying out high visibility patrols in areas we know to be most impacted by anti-social behaviour such as the Eden centre and local skate parks, we will also have an additional day of action targeting ASB this sunday




OP GROTTO PATROLS

- Be sure to check you've locked all your doors and windows before leaving





JAILED

Following an investigation by our Major Crime Unit, four men have been jailed in connection with the death of Cameron Bailey in High Wycombe.

Aaran Pattinson and Philip Solomon were each jailed for ten years and six months.

Scott Cordice was jailed for eight years and six months, and Marlon Cato was jailed for five years and six months.

This was a complex investigation, and through diligent investigative work, we were able to identify the men involved in the death of Cameron Bailey and who will now spend a significant time behind bars.



SENTENCED

Nathan Birkett, 29, (pictured), was sentenced to four months in prison at High Wycombe Magistrates Court on Thursday (21/11).

Birkett pleaded guilty to one count each of sexual assault by touching, outraging public decency, racially aggravated public order and assault on an emergency worker, at the same court in October 2024.

Investigating officer PC Daniele Morris, said: "It is a top priority of Thames Valley Police to tackle violence against women and girls in all its forms, and I am pleased that Birkett is now in prison where he belongs.
