We have been patrolling in South Bucks this evening, completing marked patrols to try disrupt any offenders in the area. The Priority Crime Team has had the support of our Special Constables and also NHPT this evening.

Officers responded to an attempt burglary on Camp Road in Gerrards Cross. Fortunately, they were not able to gain entry to the property. Our officers completed a thorough area search on foot but no persons were located. They have also been patrolling around the areas of Beaconsfield, The Chalfonts and Denham. PCSOs from the Wycombe neighbourhood team have been conducting increased patrols around Daws Hill estate in response to recent theft from motor vehicles and burglaries in the area, They have also been looking for houses in darkness during the evenings and leaving a leaflet about keeping a light on.




