A CARELESS & INCONSIDERATE DRIVING - DRIVER REPORTED


On 22/09/24, Marlow NHPT officers heard a vehicle drifting and wheel spinning in the ASDA car park at High Wycombe.

TVP TEAMWORK ENDS IN SUCCESSFUL CHARGES

On 01/10/2024, Marlow NHPT responded to the report of a stolen vehicle which was spotted on Cressex Road, High Wycombe. A short pursuit ended on Station Road in Marlow after the driver lost control and crashed his vehicle into Burgers Artisan Bakery. The driver decamped and after a short foot chase, was arrested for numerous offences. The driver Luke Barass of Lane End, High Wycombe, was charged and remanded the following day with:

- Possession of a Bladed Article
- Possession of Class B drugs (cannabis)
- Failing to Stop for Police
- Aggravated Vehicle Taking
- Dangerous Driving
- Driving Otherwise in Accordance with a License
- Driving whilst Disqualified

Barrass appeared at High Wycombe Magistrates Court on 03/10/2024, where he was remanded. He will appear in Crown Court at a later date for sentencing.


