AMan jailed for defrauding GP surgery

Nabeel Asghar has been jailed for three years for defrauding Hughenden Valley Surgery in Wycombe out of £69,000 while he was working as Practice Manager at the surgery.

His offences were sophisticated and pre meditated in nature involving the setting up of other bank accounts to facilitate the fraudulent activity.

Wrongly, fraud is often seen as a victimless crime. In this case precious public funds were stolen and this effects everyone.

Thames Valley Police is relentless in its pursuit of fraud suspects.

This week your local response officers have been busy in support of the NPCC #FatalFour operation focusing on road safety (a)

Responding to reports of a driver striking kerbs and driving on the wrong side of the road in #HighWycombe we located the car and its driver. Not only did they fail the roadside breath test but some further checks revealed that they also had no licence or insurance! The vehicle was seized and the driver was arrested, found to be almost three times the limit and was charged with all three offences \$\mathbb{a}\$

On patrol in an unmarked car in #Amersham when we were tailgated and overtaken by a driver who had decided that the 30mph speed limit didn't apply to them. Blue lights in their mirror soon put a stop to it and the driver was issued with a formal warning under S59 Police Reform Act for careless and anti-social driving

Following a report of suspicious activity around a car in #Iver we located the vehicle and its occupants, both of whom were intoxicated. The suspected driver failed the roadside breath test, was arrested and later charged for drink driving after blowing over 145ug in custody (the legal limit is 35!) .







SENTENCED 4

Following an investigation, a man has been sentenced for driving without due care and attention in Chalfont St Giles.

Zamir Berisha, aged 39, from London, was found guilty at High Wycombe Magistrates' Court on Friday. He was ordered to pay a total of £1,110 in fines, surcharges and costs.

Investigating officer PC George Ward, based at Amersham police station, said: "I am pleased that the magistrates have found Zamir Berisha guilty and passed sentence in this case.

"The fact that Berisha was not paying attention to numerous other vehicles that had stopped to let the police vehicle past, and instead overtook them, is testament to his poor care and attention to his driving during this incident.

"When you see an emergency vehicle with blue lights and sirens activated, please allow them to pass when it is safe to do so. Seconds can make all the difference in such situations, and the delays that Berisha caused could have had a significant impact on the emergency we were attending."
