

Please drive carefully and within speed limits and arrive at your destination safely





We have recently seen a number of keyless theft of motor vehicles in the Castlefield area.

If you do own a keyless car, please be aware that this technology can be exploited. By using specific devices, offenders can relay the signal from your key fob by simply being near your home and then use this to unlock your car.

To prevent this, please make use of a faraday pouch to store your key devices in, including any spare keys. You can purchase these online or from various motor retailers. It is important to check every few months or so that the pouch is still in working order.

Some key fob's have the option to turn the signal off while not in use so this may be something worth checking. It is also a good idea to not leave the key fob somewhere in the house that is generally near the car.

Please also remember general car theft prevention such as having CCTV installed and in working order on your driveway and not parking in dark secluded areas.

JAILED 🕸

Daniel Macintosh, pictured, has been jailed for 26 years after he tried to decapitate someone earlier this year.

On 23 July, Macintosh was offered work and a place to stay by the victim, a man in his sixties. At around 11.30pm, the victim awoke to a sharp, stabbing pain in his neck and was heavily bleeding.

Macintosh attempted to decapitate him.


The victim saw Macintosh stood at the end of his bed holding a bread knife. Macintosh then fled the address and discarded the knife outside a nearby property.

The victim sustained significant neck injuries and remained in hospital for a few days to undergo surgery to repair the damage caused to his neck in the attack.

It is important that the public helps us in our fight against serious violence and knife crime by reporting to us you could help save a life.

If you are worried that someone you know is using violence or is carrying a knife, please report it. We can then take the necessary steps to safeguard them and identify those responsible.

Last night we attended a disruptive unauthorised car meet in a supermarket carpark in #HighWycombe where a minority of individuals were witnessed drifting, doing burnouts and doughnuts (non edible version) and causing a risk to the general public who were still using the car park to visit the open supermarket.

We tactically pounced on two high performance BMWs seen participating in this behaviour. The drivers were both reported and their cars were seized for being involved in the anti-social driving.

A further two drivers were stopped and reported with another driver arrested for drug driving.

This level of behaviour will not be tolerated on the streets or public places. The disruption is far reaching with residents across the town hearing the commotion.

We are car enthusiasts ourselves, but these meets are not authorised and lack any safety precautions. Any loss of control or collisions can be catastrophic for the attending crowd. Additionally, your car insurance will be invalidated if you participate in this behaviour (read your policy), and it's worth considering that if someone crashes into your car whilst driving in this manner they might not have cover to repair your car or injuries.

JAILED FOR 27 YEARS 41-

Darren Robertson, pictured, was sentenced yesterday (8/11) at Aylesbury Crown Court to 27 years' imprisonment for attempted murder.

At around 1.10am on 18 February, Robertson attacked the victim, a woman in her forties, with a brick at the Melbourne Recreation Ground.

The woman sustained life-changing injuries, which required surgery.
