120 vehicles checked - x15 vehicles recorded between 31 and 35mph. x1 at 39mph.

#WindmillRoad

105 vehicles checked - x5 vehicles recorded between 31 and 35mph. x3 between 36 & 40 mph.

🤹 In response to the ongoing anti-social behaviour in the area, Bucks county council worked with police to place a partial closure order on the Dovecot carpark in High Wycombe back in July this year. The closure order works to prohibit anyone entering and dwelling in the carpark for anything other than it's intended purposes. Through working closely with representatives from Sainsburys, our business community, the carpark's security team and Bucks Council, we have seen the anti-social behaviour decreasing and can say the closure order has had an overall positive impact. Officers have also increased their patrols around the carpark and have so far carried out eight arrests in response to breaches of the closure order. Sainsburys have informed us they have also seen a reduction in shopliftings and overall crime due to the targeted action and increased police presence.

We're now working with the council to extend the closure order to be in place for a longer period of time, by doing so it will allow our partners some room to work on longer term solutions to keep the carpark secure. We will continue to work to deter and prevent criminal activity in the carpark to ensure it's a safe environment for all customers.

SENTENCED

Two men have been jailed for drugs related offences in High Wycombe.

Muhammed Hussain, aged 19, pictured left, was sentenced to two years and nine months in a youth offenders institute on Friday 20 September at Aylesbury Crown Court.

He was also ordered to pay a victim surcharge, and forfeiture of £360 in cash, drugs, and mobile phones seized.

At the same hearing, he pleaded guilty to three counts of being concerned in the supply of class A drugs, namely cocaine, crack cocaine and heroin and one count each of possession of criminal property and breach of a community order.

Usaman Hussain, pictured right, was sentenced to 10 months imprisonment and ordered to pay a victim surcharge after pleading guilty to one count of permitting premises to be used for the supply of class A drugs on Friday 20 September.

SENTENCED

Michael Bushay, pictured, was jailed for one year and two months following a hearing at Aylesbury Crown Court on Friday. He was also made subject to a five year restraining order against the victim.

Bushay pleaded guilty to one count each of assault by beating and intentional strangulation at a hearing at High Wycombe Magistrates Court on 3 May.

At around 10.30pm on 1 May this year, Bushay assaulted and strangled a woman on Mill Road, causing injuries to her.

Investigating officer PC George Ward said: "I hope the result demonstrates that violence against women and girls will not be tolerated and Thames Valley Police will always look to bring offenders to justice.

"If you are a victim, or suspect someone is a victim of crime, please contact the force. We have specialist trained officers who will listen and support you.

"You can contact us via our website, by calling 101, or by visiting a police station."
