MARLOW NHPT SPEEDING OP AT STOKENCHURCH

Following increased reports of speeding in the Stokenchurch area, Officers from Marlow NHPT carried out speed checks today.

- Numerous tickets issued
- Highest recorded speed 51mph in a 30mph zone
- More speed ops scheduled over the coming weeks

Speed > Braking distance

30mph = 14 metres

40mph = 24 metres

50mph = 38 metres

Remember: It's 30mph for a reason

Livestock worrying can have detrimental effects on our farming communities and is highly expensive for farmers. Please help your rural neighbourhood teams protect and support them by:

Keeping your dog on a secure lead at all times especially in rural areas or any areas you know will have livestock nearby, even if your dog is well trained with great recall, no dog is immune to a natural instinct to chase and you cannot predict their behaviour with absolute certainty

Please ensure all your fencing and gates are secure so there is no risk of your dog escaping and finding their way to the livestock

Failure to keep dogs under control can result in a large fine and court action, please be safe and respectful of the countryside when walking your dogs this Spring 👰

It has been a busy few days in Chesham. As part of our ongoing operations, we have seen officers from our Proactive teams, Neighbourhood Policing, British Transport Police, Roads Policing, Mounted section and intelligence department working together targeting drug activity within the town.

We have recently seen a number of comments on our social media about unlawful begging in the Wycombe town centre.

While we understand this is a reoccurring issue in the town centre, we will not be able to deal with these offences to the fullest extent without you reporting properly. If we can evidence that an individual is persistently and/or aggressively begging, we will be able to take action against them, such as applying for a criminal behaviour order.

Individuals who are struggling with homelessness, substance misuse or finances can be supported by the relevant agencies and the neighbourhood team often make referrals directly to the services for them.
