We are committed to removing drugs from our communities, which can cause so much harm, particularly to those most vulnerable.





- Don't advertise that you are going on holiday online wait to upload your snaps until you get home!
- Consider alternative deterrents like steering locks or driveway bollards
- Think about activating or installing a tracking device

Meet prolific offender Anthony Dix, aged 40, of Mendip Way, High Wycombe, who has been jailed for 47 weeks after breaching his Criminal Behaviour Order (CBO) one week after it was issued to him by the courts.

- Dix was issued a CBO on 26 November last year.
- However, on 3 December last year, he entered the Eden Shopping Centre, which he was prohibited from doing.
- Then, between 8 and 23 February this year, Dix attended businesses in High Wycombe and shoplifted multiple times.
- Dix has shown a complete disregard for the courts and now faces time in prison to reflect on his actions.


