CONVICTED

Darren Robertson, aged 38, of no fixed abode, was found guilty of attempted murder yesterday. JAILED

A man has been jailed for shoplifting incidents. Kieron Trim, pictured, was sentenced to 30 weeks in prison on 4 July at High Wycombe Magistrates Court. Trim pleaded guilty to six counts of theft from a shop, one count of attempted theft from a shop and five counts of breach of a criminal behaviour order. Between 14 and 26 June, Trim stole items, to the value of £604, from Next on Crest Road.
